NOTICE OF RACE

RULES: The regatta will be governed by the 2005 - 2008 ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the prescriptions of the United States Sailing Association, the C420 Class Association Rules, the Optimist Class Rules, the Laser Class Rules, Rules of TCYS, this Notice of Race, and the Sailing Instructions. Sailors need not be members of their respective class associations.

BOATS: BYO Optimist, Laser Standard, Laser Radial, Laser 4.7, or Club 420 (There are some 420's available to charter see below)

ELIGIBILITY: For all 2008 TCYS regattas, a sailor's age is their age on June 13, 2008

C420 and Laser sailors must be less than age 21 on June 13, 2008.

Optimist sailors must be less than age 16 on June 13, 2008.

Optimist White Fleet: Age 10 and under

Optimist Blue Fleet: Age 11 and 12

Optimist Red Fleet: Age 13 through 15

An adult advisor, parent, or coach must accompany participants under 18 years of age.

ENTRY: Entries for all fleets will be accepted at the regatta.

Checks should be made payable to the White Bear Sailing School

FEE: The entry fee is \$25 per Optimist, \$25 per Laser Standard, \$25 per Laser Radial and \$40 per C420 team. No participant will be accepted without entry fee. The entry fee is not refundable. In addition, each boat must pay the one time, annual Twin Cities Youth Sailing membership fee of \$20.

SCORING: The Low Point Scoring System will be used. If five (5) races are completed, there will be one discard, if four (4) or less are completed there will be no discards.

AWARDS: Medals to the top three (3) finishers in all fleets, ribbons from 4th to 6th; participation ribbons to all finishers in the Optimist Green Fleet.
