NOTICE OF RACE

RULES: The regatta will be governed by the 2009 - 2012 ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the prescriptions of the United States Sailing Association, the C420 Class Association Rules, the Optimist Class Rules, the Laser Class Rules, Rules of TCYS, this Notice of Race, and the Sailing Instructions. Sailors need not be members of their respective class associations.

BOATS: BYO Optimist, Laser Standard, Laser Radial, Laser 4.7, or Club 420.

ELIGIBILITY: For all 2009 TCYS regattas, a sailor's age is their age on June 19, 2009

C420 and Laser sailors must be less than age 21 on June 19, 2009.

Optimist sailors must be less than age 16 on June 19, 2009.

Optimist White Fleet: Age 10 and under

Optimist Blue Fleet: Age 11 and 12

Optimist Red Fleet: Age 13 through 15

An adult advisor, parent, or coach must accompany participants under 18 years of age.

ENTRY: Pre-registration is preferred, entries for all fleets will be accepted at the regatta.

FEE: The entry fee is \$25 per Optimist, \$25 per Laser Standard, \$25 per Laser Radial and \$40 per C420 team. No participant will be accepted without entry fee. The entry fee is not refundable.

SCHEDULE:

- 7:15 AM – Pontoons start running from Carson's Bay
- 8:00 AM – Check in and Registration in the Minnetonka Yacht Club
- 8:45 AM – Check in and registration closes
- 9:00 AM – Competitors meeting
- 10:00AM – Racing starts
- 12:00AM – Lunch (provided to competitors)
- 1:00PM – Racing resumes. We will attempt to complete 5 races for the day.

No race shall start after 3:00PM, awards to follow the last race.

SCORING: The Low Point Scoring System will be used. If five (5) races are completed, there will be one discard, if four (4) or less are completed there will be no discards.

AWARDS: Medals to the top three (3) finishers in all fleets, ribbons from 4th to all finishers in the Optimist Green Fleet and ribbons to top five in Red, White and Blue Opti fleet. The overall winners of the Optimist and C420 fleets will have their name(s) engraved on the Deephaven Centennial Regatta perpetual trophy displayed in the Minnetonka Yacht Club.
